Chair Cristina Ashjian called the meeting to order at 5:35 PM. The Minutes of the May 17th, 2010 meeting were approved without changes. Cristina announced that the application for a Barn Easement (RSA 79D) on Whittier Highway (Route 25) had been withdrawn at the Board of Selectmen's meeting of June 3, 2010. The PSU graduate student's archaeology survey project at the Moultonborough Falls industrial mill site will be completed by the end of June.

Cristina provided an update on the logistical planning underway for the Community Landmarks Tour (August 8th) including the concept for the tour brochure. On May 27th, NH Preservation Alliance staff came to Moultonborough to visit the tour sites in order to discuss property specific concerns such as appropriate parking, signage, and circulation. There will be a meeting with the NHPA next week in Concord to finalize plans. The Commission then discussed hosting assignments and specifics related to the upcoming tour. Cristina was the invited speaker at the Meredith Rotary Club on June 9th and provided an overview of the Commission's activities.

Upcoming events were noted including the "Red Hill Fire Tower" to be presented on June 24th by Ed Maheux and Prof. Thomas Hubka's talk "Big House, Little House, Back House, Barn" scheduled for July 7th. Moultonborough Historical Society events were also noted for the 4th of July (exhibition of the Kona Barn spire and weathervane) and Old Home Day on August 7th.
