Chair Cristina Ashjian called the meeting to order at 5:35 PM. The Minutes of the June 21st, 2010 meeting were approved without changes. The PSU graduate student's preliminary archaeology survey project at the Moultonborough Falls industrial mill site is completed and the Heritage Commission will receive a copy of his report. The two Community Landmarks Series lectures held at the Moultonborough Library were very well attended (77 attendees at the Red Hill Fire Tower talk on June 24<sup>th</sup>, and 120 attendees at the Connected Farms talk on July 7<sup>th</sup>).

Cristina provided an update on the logistical planning underway for the Community Landmarks Tour (August 8<sup>th</sup>), and the Commission reviewed the draft tour brochure. The Commission voted to appropriate up to \$500 from the Heritage Commission budget for the printing of the tour brochure. Jean and Cristina will meet with the NH Preservation Alliance staff on Friday, July 23rd in Concord. The Commission discussed final hosting assignments and specifics related to the upcoming tour, and agreed that all would be at the Geneva Point Center early on the tour day.
