## **Moultonborough Heritage Commission**

Chair Cristina Ashjian called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM, and the Minutes of February 11, 2015 were approved without changes. Cristina will continue as Chair, and Jean Beadle as Secretary, in the annual organization of the Heritage Commission. Norman Larson will be the representative to the new Master Plan Steering Committee (biweekly meetings April-June), and Cristina will continue as representative to the Master Plan Implementation Committee.

The Commission received updates on various matters, and will review a 2015 work plan at the May meeting. The Commission also briefly discussed potential events for the 2015 season, including a program or panel to address key vacant and/or underutilized historic buildings in Moultonborough Village, many of which are community landmarks.

Commission members were reminded of the upcoming NHPA Preservation Conference in Concord on Friday, April 17<sup>th</sup>. Other events of interest include a foundation/stone wall workshop at the Farm Museum in Milton on May 9<sup>th</sup>, and the annual NHPA Preservation Awards on May 12<sup>th</sup> (the Moultonborough Heritage Commission was an award recipient in 2011). The next HC meeting will be on Wednesday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, at 5:30 PM.
