Karen Ponton, a member of the recently established Center Harbor Heritage Commission, joined the meeting to discuss Heritage Commission Rules of Procedure, programs and events, and other relevant matters.

The Commission then discussed the planned August 24th Community Landmarks Series program to address key vacant, for sale or rent, and/or underutilized historic buildings in Moultonborough Village. These include: the Village School; the Taylor property; the Moultonborough Town House and Middle Neck School; the Moultonborough Grange Hall, the former Country Fare Inn property, and others. Panelists will include Mark Borrin, Preferred Properties; Peter Michaud, NH Division of Historical Resources, and Maggie Stier, NH Preservation Alliance.

Cristina reported that she had given a short dinner talk ‘Preserving Community Character: Opportunities for Historic Village Buildings’ for the Meredith Rotary Club on July 15th. The Commission reviewed her presentation, which will be used for the August 24th event. The event will be publicized in the next month via media and e-mail notifications.
