Minutes of August 16, 2011

The Master Plan Implementation Committee (MPIC) was called to order at 6:40 p.m.

The minutes of the May 17, 2011 were accepted as written.

The committee received two memorandums – Heritage Commission, Planning Board.

The Heritage Committee is looking forward to working with the Planning Board on the implementation of specific goals. Christina Ashjian brought up the issue of Goal 38/114 re: scenic roads and viewsheds and feels that this issue needs to be addressed quickly in the light of the issues surrounding the improvements needed on the town owned Sheridan Road. The Heritage Commission is also working on Goal 45 re: demolition review ordinance and plans to report to the Planning Board soon.

There are four chapters in Master Plan that deal with scenic road and MPIC needs to encourage the committee to discuss the road standards and see if they need to stand alone.

The Planning Board gave the MPIC a chart showing the on-going status of Goal 104 Route 25 intersections/Goal 123 Steep slopes and ridgelines/and Goal 122 protection for water resources. The Planning Board does not agree that Goals 10 Monitoring seasonal to year round occupancy and Goal 110 CIP for roads and bridges are their charges. There are other Goals (see chart) that have not been included in the 2011 work plan.

The changes shown need to be posted on the town website.
