Karin said this year has been a good year for the Red Hill Outing Club and thanked everyone for spreading the word, saying numbers have grown for 15-20 memberships last year to 50 or so memberships this year.

Jane Fairchild offered a report from the meeting held at Northwood Camp in Tuftonboro: There seems to be a great amount of interest for an indoor pool from approx. four surrounding towns. They are in the early stages with doing studies for interest, need and possibilities. A wide range of activities to service all ages is the focus.

Donna mention her department was going to bring something forth for our group to work on to address the volunteer coach accountability issue.

We will ask Becky to contact Carter and the selectman in regards to the filling of the alternate vacancy.
