## Safe Routes to School (SRtS) Task Force Meeting Monday, August 17, 2009

Mike Lancor called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m. in the SAU Conference Room at Moultonborough Academy.

Mike Izard, consultant with Lakes Region Planning Commission, (LRPC) did not arrive for the meeting. Those in attendance were able to reach Mike by phone and discovered that Mike did not have the meeting scheduled on his calendar. A decision was made to continue the meeting with Mike participating by speakerphone. Highlights of the discussion that took place are as follows:

- 1. All routes within the geographic area of study (one mile for walkers; two miles for bikers) have been surveyed for "walkability" or bikeability".
- 2. Mike Izzard faxed to the SAU office a draft copy of the SRtS Field Review that included an introduction to the field assessments conducted on July 31 and August 2, walkability and bikeability observations, summary statements and draft recommendations.
- 3. Members of the SRtS will need to finalize recommendations and develop a proposal plan to address priorities for five areas: education, enforcement, encouragement, evaluation and engineering.

Another meeting date needs to be established during which SRtS members will proceed with item #3 above.
