

Goal of the Moultonborough Milfoil Committee

Goal:

The goal of the Moultonborough Milfoil Committee (MMC) is to bring the infestation of milfoil under control in all recreational waters (both lakes and streams) within the borders of the town.

Method: Since eradication is all but impossible the effort will be continuous and rely on volunteers to perform necessary jobs each season. The following tasks:

- In conjunction with DES develop and maintain a rolling five year plan for treatment and control considering latest innovations and methodologies
- Annually develop detail people, treatment and funding requirements and implementation steps for the following year
- Develop a list and maintain contact with all homeowner associations and marinas on the waterways
- Communicate/educate through media, brochures and presentations why controlling milfoil is so important to every resident, landowner and business operator in town
- Serve as a focal point for the creation and maintenance of “Weed Watcher” and “Host Inspection” volunteers and as a repository for associated information
- Work with all relevant state agencies to support the goal of MMC
- Report to town officials, Conservation Commission and appropriate town employees on all aspects of MMC’s efforts
