

## Board of Fire Wards

June 6, 2016

Fire Wards present at the meeting were: Chief MacDonald, Cliff Plourde, Dick Moody, Dale Smith, Scott Hunter, and Wayne Blassberg

Guests: Kaleb Jacob and Tony Cardone

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chief MacDonald asked if there was a public comment before the meeting. There was none.

Item 1. Minutes were read. Scott Hunter noted that Troop 123 helped to spread the mulch that was delivered for the front of the station.

Wayne made the motion to accept the minutes with the addition of this clarification. The motion was seconded by Dick Moody. All were in favor.

Item 2. Chief MacDonald reviewed the current status of the recruit program. An application will be reviewed and discussed in non-public session. There are currently 4 applicants in the recruit program that are going through the application process.

Item 3. Chief MacDonald discussed a meeting with officers at the Tracking Station to discuss the probability of a live-in program at the Tracking Station fire station. The program would allow for volunteer coverage from 8pm to 6am. The presentation of the program was met favorably.

Item 4. The implementation of drop box for all communication regarding fire ward issues began with the minutes of this meeting.

Item 5. Chief MacDonald received clarification regarding the 1<sup>st</sup> lot of record from the Planning Board.

Following discussion, it was agreed by the Board that in a five lot subdivision fire protection should be provided for all 5 lots – either by a cistern or sprinklers. In the case of the Joe English or Peacock farm subdivision since a house was built first before additional subdivisions then a cistern should be requested.
