The purpose of the hearing is to consider proposed amendments to the Subdivision and Non-Residential Site Plan Review Regulations, as follows:

PUBLIC HEARING AT 6:30 P.M. ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS THAT WOULD AMEND:

Section IV, Procedures, Paragraph IV-G, Filing and Submission of Completed Application, 1, by amending the application submittal timeframe from 15 days to 21 days.

PUBLIC HEARING IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE NON-RESIDENTIAL SITE PLAN REVIEW REGULATIONS THAT WOULD AMEND:

Section 4, Design and Construction Requirements, paragraph 4.18, Off Street Parking, by adding a new Use and Minimum Parking Spaces Required: Medical/Dental/Veterinary or other health care provider office: 2.25 for every practitioner and 1 for every employee; and Section 7, Procedure for Planning Board Review, paragraph 7.1, by increasing 15 days to 21 days for the application submittal timeframe.
