

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

April 8, 1976

Roland Sallada, Thomas Mansfield, Oliver Andrews and Betty Hooper present.

Lester Tirrell and Elsie Warren both brought in their inventories and applied for Elderly Exemption forms.

Mr. Kenneth Marvell came in, for one thing, to complain about the way people park their cars over the sidewalk to the Town Hall. The Selectmen agreed with him and will try to do something about this.

Next, he applied for a permit on behalf of the 4-H Foundation to hold an outdoor Recreation function at the 4-H grounds to be held on Saturday June 19. Bean-0 will also be played, the permit to be picked up at a later date.

He discussed with the Selectmen the hiring of police for such a function and was disturbed over the high hourly rate of \$5.50 charged by local police officers. He said the 4-H is contemplating hiring Security Guards who work at a lower fee. The only difference being, they have no authority to arrest. He said the Fair held last September for 2 1/2 days cost the Foundation \$800 for police duty.

Fire Chief, Kenneth Barss, brought in bills to pay. He informed the Selectmen the Fire Dept. is considering the purchase of a "60 ish" fire truck. He said they hope to register it by transfer from the #3 fire truck just sold.

The Selectmen were discussing the Gravel Removal Ordinance. Roland Sallada felt that only the owner of the land should be able to apply for the permit to remove gravel. All the Selectmen agreed, but Thomas Mansfield suggested they discuss the interpretation of the Ordinance with Atty. Spielman.

The Selectmen noted while on their assessing route, that there is a bad sewer problem at the Rollins trailer which is on land owned by Victor Barss. Ethel Gagnon, health officer, will be notified of this condition and she will act in her capacity.

Dog Officer, Carolyn Strong, decided against preparing a dog list for the Town Clerk. It was decided to ask Deputy Town Clerk, Sandra Gendron to do it.
