

SPECIAL MEETING

September 7, 1976

The Board of Selectmen and the School Board met for a special meeting at the Selectmen's Office. All were present.

The custodial duties of the school and the town hall were discussed and it was agreed by all present that the school custodian would have the responsibility of cleaning up each day immediately after the school lunch was over and leave the hall set up for the following day.
