

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

March 17, 1977

Present were Thomas Mansfield, Oliver Andrews, Roland Sallada and Betty Hooper.

Walter & Lucie Wickerman came in to complain about road drainage causing problems with their septic tank and other damage to their property. They feel this the responsibility of the town and that the town should pay for repairs. The Selectmen agreed to view the situation.

Mr. & Mrs. Frank Crawford came in to discuss their plans to start building a home and living in the cellar until the house is completed. They will fill out a Building Permit form. They were advised that they may proceed with their plans.

Walter Leach, Jr. came in to inquire on a drive-way permit for Mr. Wayne Magarian. The Selectmen will inspect it in the morning.

The necessary appointments to the various committies for 1977-78 were made.

Roland Sallada moved that Thomas Mansfield serve as Chairman of the Board of Selectmen for the following year. The vote was unanimously passed.

Roland questioned whether the zoning ordinance permitted a change of commercial use in a property without going through the Board of Adjustment. It was decided the case in question would be accepted, this being the Patrick Welsh auction property being converted to a restaurant.
