Bids on the town offices conversion were opened.

- a. Linwood Building Corp : \$29,034.00
- b. William Larss Constr. : 17,936.67

Both bids were in excess, therefore the Selectmen rejected all bids.

Mrs. Richard Warnock requested and received her 45-day temporary trailer permit.

The Selectmen called Sen. Saggiotes of Newport relative to the extension of open burning at the town dump. They were informed that HB #197 has passed both the House and Senate and is now in a conference committee. In the opinion of Sen. Saggiotes, the bill is expected to pass.
