Plans were being made to clean out the old fire house in preparation for construction work which will start on the conversion to town offices on July 11.

George Hawkins presented a sub-division plan of the John Mizek property on Bedford Road. He also obtained 12 drive-way permits.

Yvonne Gomes was nominated to serve on the Board of Adjustment as alternate.
