

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

August 4, 1977

The Selectmen met with town counsel, David Nixon and his associate, J. K. Hage, to discuss the outcome of the Nakton vs. the Town of New Boston case in regard to the hearing held with the Tax Commission. Thomas Mansfield and Oliver Andrews were present, with Betty Hooper taking notes. Mr. Nixon advised that, having no choice, to refund the overpayment and interest as recommended by the Commission, but suggested a letter be written to Mr. Splaloss expressing disappointment in the handling and attitude of the Tax Commission in regard to this case. (Following their departure, Roland Sallada arrived.)

Randy Karker came in representing the Conservation Commission in regard to the appraisal of the Piscataquog River property which is to be acquired under the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation project #33@00269. The State Commissioner, Mr. Gilman, is not satisfied with the original appraisal, so the Conservation Commission will get new appraisals.

Three Gravel Removal Permits were approved for Charles Townes.

Ella Daniels accepted the appointment to the Planning Board as alternate.

Nonah Poole was re-appointed to the SNEPC.

Building and driveways permits were approved for Normand Beaugard.
