Present were Thomas Mansfield, Oliver Andrews, Roland Sallada and Betty Hooper.

The Selectmen met with August Gomes at 10:00 am to discuss the fire house addition project.

Mr. Gomes that Mrs. Leon Daniels had approached the North Branch Ruidlers, who is doing the construction, and warned them about trespassing on her property, which is the road side of the fence which the Daniels erected.

It was agreed that Mr. Gomes would be overseer of the fire house addition.

The Conference Room at the new Town Office building was discussed. The Historical Society is having problems finding someone to do the cabinet work, etc. It was decided to ask Mr. Robert Gaither to finish the room.

Mr. Gomes askedpermission to engage Alan Moeller for assistance on the Tax ${\tt Map.}$ Permission was granted.

The Town Hall septic system was brought up. The Selectmen are concerned in regard to the high bid which was offered by Harold Strong. It was voted to give the project to Mr. Strong, but to make every effort to keep the cost as low as possible.

Mr. Gomes asked about wages for the engineering of the town projects. He was asked to present a bill for his work on the fire house addition and the town septic system separately.
