

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

October 20, 1977

Present were Roland Sallada, Oliver Andrews and Betty Hooper.

Mr. & Mrs. Bourque came into check on their driveway permit.

Mr. Donald Holt came in to file a permit to remove gravel from his property. He was informed that he is in violation of the Gravel Ordinance since he did not apply until the gravel performance was completed. Also, he had received a letter in 1972 barring all further gravel removal from his property.

A group from the Tirrell trailer park came in to inquire about the status of their private road. Those present were: Mr. Kinner, Mr. Kissel, Mr. Cloutier, Mr. Savaria and Mr. Michaud. The lot on which the Community well is located was discussed. All agreements on the sale of lots at the trailer park and water and road situations were verbal with Mr. Tirrell and those present report that Mr. Tirrell is not keeping his word. He has installed two culverts, but has not tarred the road as was agreed at Town Meeting. They asked for a letter from the Selectmen to dictate the specifications of the road, which he promised.

They asked if the tarred road would increase their taxes, and they were assured it would not.

They were advised the average mile of road costs about \$38,000 per mile to build.

Mr. Louis Kachavos presented a map of his property to demonstrate the probability of re-directing the road at a further distance from his house.

Mr. Everett Upton brought in pertinent information regarding town ~~owned~~ owned land located in the center of the Wagner Woodland acreage. He explained that John Conley also owns acreage in this section.

Robert Getman came in to ask the Historical Society to remove some glass cases from his basement - he needs the room.

OCTOBER 26, 1977

Mr. Starkey filed an intent to cut. He delivered the form and presented it to the Secretary to the Selectmen that they may act on it and sign the permit. He is lumbering the property of Donald Holt on Lull Road.
