

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

NOVEMBER 17, 1977

Members of the Recreation Commission came in to discuss the unfinished project of the Ronald Daniels Tennis Court. Present were: Sandra Gallup, Laura DeCato, Lois Hersey and Martha Eiermann. All members of the Board of Selectmen were present.

Roland Sallada moved we give all records of the Tennis Court project to the safe keeping of the Commission for their files. The motion was seconded by Oliver Andrews. This project was started by Janet Nixon in 1975 and she has been chairman of the project up to this year when Sandra Gallup was elected president of the Commission. Roland suggested the president be responsible to complete this project. A letter from the Selectmen will accompany the president when she meets with the State Recreation Commission, Mr. Splalos.

Warren Moss was asked to meet with the Selectmen in regard to the condition of the Town Hall which has not been in sanitary condition. He was asked who had keys to the Town Hall. He said Sandra Gallup and Marion Woodbury each had a set.

He was asked how many hours were spent on the Town Hall. He said each day was different. It was requested he put the storm windows in place and clean more thoroughly and clean the Common. He agreed.

Richard Moore and Richard Moody of Plastic Techniques, Inc. asked for a privileged use of the Town dump. Two days a week are not sufficient. They must keep the plant clean or they will have trouble with OSHA. They applied for one other day of disposal, preferably Thursday afternoon. They explained they are sorting the trash from the plastic, which is disposed at the lower dump. They are willing to pay an extra fee.

Permission was granted. Mr. Houghton will accompany them on the extra day.

William Forest came by request to discuss the completion of the Conference Room. He has agreed to do the work in his spare time and also work nights.

Roland Sallada made the motion that starting December 1, a fee of \$5 be charged for every drive-way permit. The motion was seconded by Thomas Mansfield. A letter will be forwarded to the Planning Board notifying them of this new rule.

A building permit was issued to H. Randall and Gail Pakrer to add a porch to the back side of their home.

A trailer permit was requested by J. Russell Lee of Riverdale Road, new owner of the James Hawkes, Sr. place.

Dr. Brooks was nominated to serve on the Planning Board to finish the term of Brandy Vanden Berg who has resigned. He accepted.

Mary Towle was nominated to serve the Planning Board as alternate and act as its recording secretary.

Gravel renewal permits were issued to Charles H. Towne and Donald Byam.
