December 1, 1977

Present were Thomas Mansfield, Oliver Andrews, Roland Sallada and Betty Hooper.

A trailer hearing was held for Mr. & Mrs. Fred Arsenault. Attending the hearing were Mr. Arsenault, Mr. Kissel and Mr. Warnock. Mr Warnock moved, that since this lot had been previously accepted for a trailer, which permit was not used, the application be approved.
