January 13, 1978

Martha Dodge Jenkinson came in to put an Article in the Warrant to amend the Zoning Ordinance to read that the members of the Board of Adjustment be voted by ballot at Town Meeting. Mr. Mansfield reviewed the law and advised her she would need to petition the town with at least 25 names to present to the Planning Board, who in turn would set up the necessary hearings. She then realized the procedure is too lengthy and she will have to wait for another year.
