

SPECIAL MEETING - Information Hearing - Air Pollution Control Jan. 23, 1978

Three Selectmen and Betty present. The meeting opened at 8:30 pm in the town hall. Mr. Sallada asked for reports from the members of the Dump Committee, in the absence of their chairman, David Woodbury.

Dr. Brooks reported the committee set up specifications for town rule to go along with the Solid Waste Disposal Ordinance of the State, plus asking for a performance bond.

Mr. Mansfield asked about an engineering plan with the state. Dr. Brooks advised that the state will not approve anything until we are in the operating stage.

In regard to the use of the Lydia Dodge lot, Harold Strong said he has examined the location and there is plenty of sand to operate a very good job of land fill. He also said that the road will need very little work. He said the site is one mile from Frank Wilson's corner. Duncan Fund money is available for this purpose. Mr. Strong felt the care of the dump would work well in conjunction with the Road Agent operation.

Two estimates were offered: \$19,500 and \$18,600 to contract the job. In the event that the operation was under the Road Agent, the town would either have to buy a loader or rent one.

The State safety rules say there must be a telephone or some communication at the site, and possibly a building for the equipment, with a full time custodian who would handle the stump dump and who would have the benefit of all salvage. It was recommended that the stump dump be moved up with the other dump for better control.

Mr. Mansfield compared costs of the Souhegan Land ^{fill} with a town owned dump, the our own dump would be cheaper. Duncan ^{fund} money and Excess Highway subsidy funds will be available for the road.

Andy Belanger preferred the town own its pay loader versus renting one.

The Selectmen asked for a show of hands whether they should have one or two proposals in the warrant. The vote was over-whelmingly for only one article. Meeting was adjourned at 9:30, closing all further ^{hearing}
