

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

April 20, 1978

Present were Roland Sallada and Betty Hooper.

Public Official Insurance Bonds arrived by mail and signatures were affixed and witnessed.

Donald Ryan came in to ask what steps should be taken to widen the road into the H-H grounds from Route 13. Land owned by Leon and Ella Daniels abutts the road and the Daniels' have agreed to donate the land needed. The question arose whether this would require a subdivision. Bo Strong said he felt if Mr. Daniels would deed the property to the H-H Foundation, it would suffice.

The Foundation also plans to place about four ^{yard} ~~street~~ lights along the route.

Armand Hebert came in to inquire if John Winslow has a junk yard permit. The answer was no. He requested that the Selectmen do something about the bad situation of many vehicles all over the property which is located in front the Hebert property.

John Bunting came in representing the fire wards. They would like to introduce a system of having houses all over town numbered. Also setting up and establishing proper street and road names. They would need a metric measuring wheel to perform the job, and asking the town to assist in the financing.
