John Bunting came in to report further on the Fire Department project of numbering all houses in New Boston. He is looking for financing of the necessary Measuring Wheel in the amount of \$87. He contacted Mr. Gomes but Mr. Gomes said that the Tax Map appropriation was all spent. The Selectmen agreed that this apparatus would be important to many town officials and will consider financing from Civil Defense funds. This project will definitely be handled as a town function.

The following drive-way permits were approved: David Fern and Frank Solangelo, both needing culverts.
