Re: John Winslow v. Town of New Boston

Junk Yard Case

Attending Court Case were Roland Sallada and Thomas Mansfield at the Goffstown Municipal Court.

The Court kept in their possession Town evidence which includes a copy of a letter dated June , 1978; a letter to the Board of Selectmen from Armand Hebert outlining his complaint of the condition of the Winslow property which he described in violation of the Junk Yard Ordinance; a list of cars housed on the Winslow property at the time of inspection on June 8, 1978 by Police Chief John Ballou, Sel. Oliver Andrews and Sel. Roland Sallada; copy of Revised Trailer Ordinance. An application form for abatement of assessment by Mr. Hebert was retained by the Selectmen. Reason for application: Junk Yard is located in front of the Hebert property which he claims depreciates his property.

RESULTS OF COURT CASE

The judge took the case under advisement and will give findings at a later date.
