

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

November 16, 1978

Present were Oliver Andrews, Roland Sallada, Thomas Mansfield and Betty Hooper.

The Selectmen met with the Town Hall Committee at 7:30 to resolve some of the problems regarding a new custodian. Howard Towne informed us that he has asked Ivan Byam to work 9 hours each week for the \$45 paid. Ivan agreed to work only until the end of the month. Mr. Mansfield and Mr. Sallada both reported having been approached by others now interested in the job. After a thorough discussion on all angles, it was agreed to ask Ivan to work extra hours in order to get the town hall in presentable condition and to ask him to consider staying on the job until the end of the year. One member of each organization in town will be invited to meet with the Board of Selectmen and the Town Hall Committee on November 30 at 7:30 pm to further discuss the use of the town hall.

There was continued discussion of the use of a dumpster outside the town hall. Members of the Town Hall Committee will check further with the possibility of returning the school dumpster to the town hall for combined use.

Building permits were approved for Ray Burgess and Alfred Copertino. A driveway permit was approved for Robert Beaulieu.

On the resignation of Errol Upton from the Conservation Commission, Patricia Getman was appointed to finish his term - expiration date, 1981.
