

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

November 30, 1978

Present were ~~Six~~ Thomas Mansfield, Roland Sallada and Betty Hooper.

A trailer hearing was held at 8:15 regarding the application of Janet Hadley to place a trailer on her land on Cochran Road. Present at the hearing were Janet Hadley and Dwight Davis. Mr. Mansfield moved, seconded by Mr. Sallada, that the permit be approved. A letter of verification will follow along with a 45-day temporary permit.

Mr. Richard Turosh, Robert Locke and Jonathan Brooks came in to question the assessment on their properties.

Catherine Tiley and her son, David Tiley, came in to complain about the expansion of the business conducted by Walter Dickerson at his home which abutts the Tiley property. They felt it would depreciate their property. Furthermore, they noted that Mr. Dickerman had the addition nearly finished and has only now filed a building permit with the Selectmen. The Selectmen promised to have a meeting with Mr. Dickerman next Thursday before approving the permit.

The Board of Selectmen voted to give permission to Marian and Roland Sallada to use the Town Seal as the emblem for a shoulder patch for the members of the Fire Dept. They also extended permission to the Historical Society for the use of the Town Seal on a license plate.
