Walter & Lucie Dickerman came in regarding a building permit to make an addition to their garage to expand their business. Permission granted.

Roger & Eileen Paradis came in to ask permission to haul lumber through town property on existing roads. Permission granted.

Homer Dodge came in to discuss insurance coverage on cemetery property. The town has been carrying Workmen's Compensation on cemetery employees which should have not been done. This will be cancelled.

Larry Daley came in to ask who held the responsibility of programs affiliated with the Recreation Commission. He was advised that the Selectmen allow the Commission free rein, provided no problems arise. He has been running into problems introducing some of his projects and asked for the support of the Selectmen. They agreed. There was some discussion on carrying liability insurance. This is being looked into.

The Selectmen again met with the Town Hall Committee.
