

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

March 8, 1979

Present were Oliver Andrews, Thomas Mansfield and Betty Hooper.

The Selectmen met with the Town Hall Committee. A discussion ended with the dismissal of town hall custodian, Ivan Byan, as of April 1, 1979. A notice will be published in the paper requesting applications to fill the custodian job. There was discussion as to what would still be needed to improve the town hall and the following items were mentioned: install fire alarms, replace the lighting system with flurescent lights; the upper town hall stair well and ceiling to be washed and painted, but due to the extensive height, this job to be contracted. Locks for the doors will be replaced. Another meeting will be scheduled after town meeting when the appropriation will be voted.

k Peter Herbert came in with his surveyor to describe his subdivision plans. They wanted to make sure everything is in order before going before the Planning Board.

William Locke came in to report that the Board of Adjustment did not feel his building permit whould have been referred to them. They suggested he return to the Board of Selectmen for reconsideration. The Selectmen agreed that if the present structure is connected to his new structure, it can be handled as an addition. He plans to go this route.

Mr. & Mrs. Daniel Zwillinger came in to try to resolve the problem with the assesment on their property for the years 1977 and 1978.
