

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

April 19, 1979

Present were Roland Sallada, Thomas Mansfield, Merrill Todd and Betty Hooper.

Mr. Frederick Cleveland came in to ask for an extension to his permit to place a trailer on his property. Extension was granted until May 31.

Two driveway permits were issued to Winfield Lovejoy; Permit to build new home issued to Roger Gagnon; Permit to build roof on trailer issued to Philip Taylor.

Mrs. Finnerty, new owner of the Edbridge Welch house, submitted a building permit to conduct a small home buisness with herself being the only employee. Approved.

The Selectmen appointed Ted Olson as member to the Board of Adjustment Plastic Techniques was granted permission to ~~got~~-top the road adjacent to their property. in Central Square.

Mr. Raymond Hebert was asked to come in to explain why he had dumped a good deal of trash just ov er the gate ~~xxxx~~ of the town dump at a time when the dump was closed. He said Police Chief Ballou had already spoken to him about it and he promised it would never happen again. A \$10 ~~fine~~ charge was requested and paid. *To depray cost of clean-up.*
