Ray Damour , of the State Tax Commission, discussed the 1978 valuation on the Public Service Co. of N. H. with Roland Sallada. The Public Service records show a valuation of \$516,760; however the State Tax Commission , using the Handy-Whitman Index, compute the valuation as \$883,100.
