

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

August 30, 1979

Present were Roland Sallada, Thomas Mansfield, Merrill Todd and Betty Hooper.

The Selectmen met in Executive Session at 8:00 pm with Roger Follansbee regarding a Court hearing scheduled for August 31, at 9:00 am pertaining financial allocation for Mr. Follansbee's two daughters who have been placed in a Foster Home. (See minutes of the meeting filed in Welfare folder)

Lucille Fales asked if it was possible to build a house and live in her present house until the new one was complete. The Ordinance prohibits two dwellings on one property. She said she plans to convert the present house to a barn. The Selectmen advised either connecting the two structures with a breezeway or go through subdivision.

Donald Hyam asked for a permission to place a sign advertising the Hillsborough County Fair on the town oval. Permission granted.
