

Sept 11, 1980

Notes of telephone conversations with J. Marden  
on 9/11/80.

Mr. Marden called me about 10 A.M. to  
tell me that he had conversed with Tom  
Mausfield last evening, and not being able to  
contact him this forenoon - he was calling  
me.

Apparently the late Mr. Robt Weddick's  
son Eddie, had shown up at the funeral  
services on Wed 9/10. Mr. Marden & Mr. E.  
Weddick had conversed on the phone this  
A.M. and Mr Eddie wished Mr. Marden to  
permit Mr Eddie to enter the Weddick  
residence, to reclaim some un-named  
articles related to his Mother & family.  
Mr Eddie refused to conduct his search  
of the premises accompanied by a dis-  
interested witness, or by Mr Marden or  
a member of the Board of Selectmen.

I told Mr. Marden that I felt that  
this was an unwarranted request <sup>by Mr. Weddick</sup> and  
Mr. Marden felt that Mr. Mausfield had

expressed the same feelings on the evening of 9/10.

At about 11:30 A.M. this morning (9/11/80) Mr. Marden called back. He said Mr. Eddie Weadick refused to comply with 'Mr. Marden's' and our position, and had hung up on Mr. Marden. Mr. Marden also told me he had suggested to Mr. Weadick that he (Mr. E. Weadick) should ask to be appointed Administrator, but Mr. Weadick gave Mr. Marden no answer either negatively or affirmatively.

Thus endeth my report on my activities the forenoon of 9/11/80
