

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

June 11, 1981

The three Selectmen and secretary were present to meet with the Library Trustees and Mr. Michael Ingram, architect for the new library addition and also Mr. Michael Eckman, contractor, at 7:00 pm.

Eckman Construction was low bidder with a figure of \$159,900. Mr. Ingram negotiated therefore Mr. Eckman was able to lower the bid to \$133,560. Some of the changes were: substitute brand of electrical fixture; dropped enclosed staircase; brick wall eliminated; omit some storage space; omitted refrigerator and cook-top. All the Trustees are in agreement with the changes. Bonds will be posted. The contract was signed by all three Selectmen.
