Three Selectmen present and secretary.

The Selectmen met at 7:00 pm with the Board of Adjustment, members present being William Brendle, Donald Byam and Joseph Sisk. The rem problem discussed was relative to the trailer hearing requested by Edmund Novick to place a trailer on his property located on Route 114 where on which a commercial building all ready exists. After reviewing all aspects thoroughly, the final decision was that the lot had been approved for commercial wave purposes and could not be subdivided being the lot contains only 2.8 acres, therefore the application must be denied since it does not conform to the ordinance. The members of the Board of Adjustment also reminded the Selectmen that Mr. Novick has not as yet complied to the special exception which their Board had specified when granted his application. The members then brought up the subject of the special exception granted to Burnham Fuel Co. They stated that the owner, Mr. LaPlant, has never complied with his grant, and it is their opinion that the area is very untidy.

It was reported that there will be a special Planning Board meeting on October 27 to discuss the will of the people regarding Cluster housing, Condominiums and Multi-housing. It was stressed that the Board make sure the public be properly informed with each term definitely defined.

John Bunting reported the fire dept. inspected the school and found the furnace to be unsafe, the problem being the burner. They have given the school board two weeks to make repairs. If the problem has not been taken care of in this time, the fire dept. will close the school
