Burns Agency, Inc. is doing a complete survey of the town and would like each department to make an inventory of all equipment and present it to the insurance company so as to come up with the proper coverage. It was suggested that Police Professional Coverage be carried ~~to~~ in the event of false arrest or wrongful seizure. Being as the town has had no claims against Workman's Compensation, a dividend will be received by the town. The Agency asked to be notified immediately of any new equipment added.

Many inventories were accepted.

Andrew Belanger came in to find out if it were permissible to place another trailer on the site of the trailer which burned. Could this be done under the grandfather ~~is~~ clause. The Selectmen will look further into the matter.
