

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

December 30, 1982

Three Selectmen and secretary present.

The Selectmen met with Town Counsel, David L. Nixon and Robert Todd, surveyor, regarding boundaries on the former Town Shed land purchased by Herbert Scott. With two different deeds declaring different boundaries, a decision had to be reached so as to write up a new deed. Mr. Todd pointed out markers on a map as he found them. It was agreed that the 1956 deed would ~~be used allowing a right-of-way to Richard Hall~~ be used allowing a right-of-way to Richard Hall. The Selectmen will request that Mr. Hall forfeit the original 1956 deed to this property. If for any reason the deal with Mr. Scott should not terminate, the Selectmen would ask that Mr. Scott notify the Selectmen by letter.

Atty. Nixon promised the new deed would be ready for signatures by Monday Jan. 3, 1983 6:00 pm. The deed for the Molly Stark land, bought by the Kennedy Brothers was also given to Atty. Nixon for rewriting.

Dump custodian, George Houghton, has been ill for the past two weeks necessitating appointing a substitute. Due to some mix-up, Sele Mansfield moved that the responsibility of hiring a substitute would remain with the Road Agent, being as he has supervision over the dump. The motion passed.
