

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

MAY 11, 1987

Selectmen Dodge, Olson, Mansfield and secretary present.

7:10 Maurice Whipple, Charles Gordon, Bill Hodgen and Bo Strong were present for a meeting concerning Maurice Whipple subdivision off Route 114. Maurice Whipple was scheduled to grade, seed and hay the shoulders in the development. Charles Gordon would prefer Mr. Whipple to do this later in the year (Fall of 1987). Mr. Gordon is concerned with disturbing the shoulders after they have been seeded when he has his homes delivered to each lot. Mr. Gordon agreed to repair any damage caused by him and seed and hay the shoulders this fall. The next meeting with the above parties is scheduled for August 10, 1987. Mr. Whipple will meet with Bill Boisvirt on location to discuss any repairs or alterations to the shoulders at the present time.

8:00 Mrs. Lillian Foote came in to discuss the finish grading of the shoulders in relation to her property on Bedford Road. Selectmen scheduled Lee Murray, Road Agent to call Mrs. Foote 5/12/87 at 7AM. Lee would schedule a time to meet Mrs. Foote on location to discuss the grading further.

Mrs. Gauthier came in and asked the secretary when she receives the letter of application for a temporary trailer if she would write on the letter that they request the temporary trailer permit for twelve (12) months.

8:10 Mr. Ronald Burd and Karen Cannon came in to discuss the future possibilities of developing Mr. Paul Altman's property on Wilson Hill Road. Selectmen informed them of the road impact study and that they would also be working along with the Planning Board. The Selectmen informed Mr. Burd that they had the ability to open a class 6 road, however would expect the developer to bring the road up to town specifications.

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Mr. Burd asked about right aways and the Selectmen suggested that he first speak with Mr. Clifton LaBree and Mr. Herbert Scott who are abutters.

8:35 George Whipple came in to pick up application for a gravel permit for G.F. Construction. G. & F. Construction purchased Robert Colburn's gravel pit and wanted to have the gravel permit tranferred to G. & F. Mr. Colburn's permit was for only 200 yards and G. F. Construction would be for at least 10,000 yards per year. He was told that G. & F. would have to apply and have a gravel hearing. Mr. Whipple will have the application filled out and return to the office.

8:45 Matt Yakovakis was in to see if he could get \$80,000.00 from his escrow account. The road to his development off Bedford Road is 90% complete. Selectmen agreed to \$60,600.00 Karen Craven, Town treasurer will send him a check.

9:00 John Ballou came in with a couple of bills.

9:25 Donald Grosso came in to see if the Selectmen had reached a decision on whether he has to go before the Board of Adjustment to have the Video store move into his complex. The Selectmen will come to a decision after they meet with the chairman of the Board of Adjustment.

Selectmen authorized the office staff to receive computer instructions from Joseph Foistner of G. & F. Construction. Joseph Foistner intends to donate three (3) computers to the Town.

Selectmen sign checks, current use and intent to cut forms and reviewed other corespondence.

Meeting adjourned 11:30
