They felt as long as the attendance were 35 and under they did not need to go to the Board of Adjustment for a varience. Selectmen will look into this situation further and get back to Mr. Grosso.

Louis Maynard and Edward Gallagher came in to see what stage the Selectmen were at concerning the slit in the river. Selectmen Dodge has made calls to Concord and he was refered to contact the Soil Conservation Comm. in Milford, N.H. He plans on contacting them and will be back in touch with Mr. Maynard and Mr. Gallaher.

Mirk Drew was in to discuss his septic problem.

Frank Welton called to discuss an extension on his temporary trailer permit. He will submit a letter requesting the extension. Sel. granted the extension per telephone conversation. The extention is until 12/21/87.

Jim Dodge came in to discuss appointing a Forest Fire Warden for the third shift at the New Boston Tracking Station.
