

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

November 2, 1987

7:50 Jay Harwood, WE-XL came in to go over plans on the transfer station and he left an additional estimate on walls that were left out of plans for the roll off container.

8:20 Ted Fredenburgh came in to express his feelings on the bid for concrete work for the transfer station. He felt the Selectmen should have accepted his bid.

8:30 Richard Messina came in to go over his denial on his 65,500 yard permit and to discuss approval on his renewal 10,000 yard gravel permit. Selectmen reviewed the traffic and road problems and felt that his 10,000 yard permit has the same problems. Mr. Messina was willing to limit the number of trucks per day. Selectmen told Mr. Messina that they would have to consider this renewal further and would get back to him.

9:50 Karen Hall from the New Boston Friends of Recreation was in to inform the Selectmen that the Jr. Athletic League decided not to join the Friends of Recreation Department. Karen asked if the downstairs of the Town Hall could be used for babysitting during the morning aerobics. The program participants were to understand that the Town was not liable.

10:05 Representative from Colonial Insurance Co. was in to explain disability and cancer programs.

10:20 Mr. & Mrs. Clough came in to inquire about the rules and regulations of building on a class six (6) road. Property cannot be subdivided unless the road was upgraded to Town Spec. Building permit comes from the Selectmen and they review this with the Planning Board. The property owners have to sign a agreement that the Town will not be liable for any services (fire, police, etc.).

10:45 Sandra Gallup from the Friends of Recreation was in to inform the Selectmen the decision that the Jr. Athletic League did not want to join with Friends of Recreation.

11:00 Lee Murray, Road Agent question if he should repair the culvert on Greenfield Road or block off that section of road. Selectmen agreed to have him repair the culvert.

11:45 Donald Grosso to inform the Selectmen that he was in a dispute with the Board of Adjustment on their decision of his hearing.

12:15-1:30 Selectmen signed checks, reviewed mail and reviewed pending subjects.
