

Selectmen's Meeting January 9, 1989

Present were Selectmen Dodge, Olson, and Mansfield.

Sandra Gendron asked if Naomi Bolton could receive \$21.00/week for her benefit in place of Matthew Thornton Health Plan for January 1989- August 1989 during her pregnancy. When she returns back to work in November she will be offered only Matthew Thornton Health Plan.

A meeting to review the budget for Capital Improvements were held. Present were Planning Board members Harold Strong, Mike Richard, Ella Daniels, Claire Dane, Donald Grosso, and Brent Armstrong. Lee Murray representing Highway Department and Dan MacDonald Fire Department.

Lee mentioned maybe it was time to look into leasing equipment. Selectman Olson said in the past equipment was put on the Town Warrant as special articles so the Town's people could vote on the particular item. Donald Grosso asked if the Town could borrow long term for equipment. Selectman Olson stated it would have to be voted 2/3 major vote at Town Meeting. Harold Strong stated he would like to see equipment paid for in two years (2) and road improvements be paid over a long term maybe five (5) years. Harold Strong would like to review CIP each year. Selectman Mansfield suggested if the Town used a five (5) year plan it would spread the Town too thin if something unexpected came up.
