

MINUTES OF THE SELECTMEN'S MEETING - June 24, 1991

The only Selectman present for the meeting was Chairman of the Board Johnston, Selectman Dodge and Selectman Olson were both unavailable due to work commitments. Sandra Gendron took minutes.

One of the scheduled orders of business for the evening was the opening of the bids for work to be done at the cemetery. Present from the Cemetery Trustees were Robert Todd and Jerry Kennedy. Bids were received from George Kelliher, Inc. in the amount of \$7,800.00, DCA Engineering in the amount of \$4850.00 and Eric Mitchell & Associates in the amount of \$7,800.00. It was suggested by Selectman Johnston that the bids be reviewed by the Trustees and a recommendation be made by them to the Board of Selectmen.

Frank Fillmore was in to inquire as to what work was being done to Butterfield Mill Road since he was of the opinion that any work to be done was going out to bid. Selectman Johnston stated that he did not have an answer to the inquiry. Selectman Johnston told Frank that the trees that had been cut for installation of the telephone poles on Butterfield Mill Road were still there and needed to be removed. Frank agreed to see that they were removed. Later in the evening, Selectman Dodge called in and when asked stated that Lou Rumore had been authorized by Road Agent Lee Murray to use his equipment to pound some of the larger rocks and this was being done. Frank Fillmore was contacted and told what was being done.

A letter was received by the Board of Selectmen from Bonnie Bethune Manager of the Transfer Station expressing her displeasure that the waste oil that had been collected at the June 2, 1991 at the HWC Day was still at the Transfer Station and had not been removed since the Board of Selectmen had chosen a different course of action other than what had been contracted for by Mike Richard Coordinator of the Collection Day. She further provided documentation that stated requirements that would be necessary to meet before the oil could be transported or accepted by a user of waste oil.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m. since no official business could take place with only one Selectman present.
