

MINUTES OF THE SELECTMEN'S MEETING - April 13, 1992

Present for the meeting which began at 7:00 p.m. were Selectmen Dodge, Johnston and Pimenta with Sandra Gendron taking minutes.

Road Agent Lee Murray was in for his regular weekly meeting with the Board. Discussion began with Lee stating that a demonstration of the apparatus to be used for patching cracks in paved roads would be available at the Selectmen's convenience. The purchase of this equipment was discussed prior to Town Meeting, the funds will come from resurfacing monies. It was agreed that Friday would be acceptable and the demonstration would take place on Ridgeview Lane.

When asked, Lee stated that he is currently paying \$1.25 per yard for gravel from Messina and Fillmore, \$1.50 per yard from Towne and Gomes and \$1.75 from Leach. These are "unloaded" prices.

Lee commented that he was "playing by ear" lifting the weight limits currently imposed on the roads. He stated he was allowing one or two loads, no logging operations, and he was trying to accommodate the needs of someone who might be pouring a foundation.

Ken Rhodes, Engineer for the Depot Street Replacement Bridge Project, had been scheduled for an appointment during this time, but never appeared.

The Board of Selectmen next reviewed the job description for a Cemetery Superintendent that had been rewritten by Cemetery Trustee Robert Todd, as directed at the Selectmen's Meeting the previous Monday evening. The proposal will be put out to bid, bids to be opened on May 4th at 7:00 p.m.

Next discussed were the various appointments that would be necessary to the Committees and Commissions for which the Selectmen make said appointments. All chairpersons had been, or would be in the near future contacted, and asked to submit to the Board of Selectmen those reappointments or vacancies that were applicable. It was voted unanimously to reappoint Richard Moody for another term of service on the Road Committee. There is one vacancy on that Committee which will go on a list of all vacancies that will eventually be advertised to the public in the hope of attracting interest persons. The Recreation Commission was next discussed, two names having been submitted as can be noted in the minutes of 04-06-92. Karen will be contacted to make certain there are no other Friends of Recreation interested in moving to the Recreation Commission, if there are not, then it was voted unanimously to appoint Deborah Billigan and David Mulick whose names have been submitted to the Board of Selectman. On the matter of the Planning Board, Selectman Johnston moved and Selectman Dodge seconded with both voting to appoint Alternate Lucien Tessier to become a full member of the Board. Selectman Pimenta abstained from voting on this position feeling he did not have sufficient background on the Board or the persons involved at this time to vote. This would leave an alternate position open for the Planning Board which will be placed on the above mentioned list.

Checks were signed, mail was reviewed and the meeting adjourned at 9:20 p.m.
