Present for the meeting which began at 7:00 p.m. were Selectmen Dodge, Johnston and Pimenta with Sandra Gendron taking minutes.

There was no agenda for the evening.


Selectmen Dodge and Johnston had walked the area in the vicinity of the Office of Heidi Palmer Real Estate the previous Friday investigating a complaint from the Palmer's with regard to septage running onto their property. This not being a new problem, the Selectmen reviewed the history for the benefit of Selectman Pimenta. They found the system on the Mace property on Old Coach Road apparently overflowing. The Board will follow through informing the property owner of the conditions and the health hazard that is constituted. The Palmer's will be kept abreast of the situation. General discussion followed with regard to the future potential necessitating the installation of a central sewage system in the area of New Boston Village.

Selectman Pimenta stated that he had accompanied Road Agent Lee Murray to his scheduled meeting with Lynne Higbie, Bittersweet Lane regarding the road accessing her home. Ms. Higbie agreed that the circle could be cut down and widened at the beginning creating an area whereby winter maintenance vehicles could turn around.

Selectman Pimenta requested that his contention be included in the minutes, that at the Selectmen's Meeting of September 27, 1993 he had been instructed to provide to the Goffstown News the proceedings of the Selectmen's Meetings. Selectman Johnston stated that any material to be submitted be reviewed by the Board before submission, a statement to which Selectman Dodge agreed.

Mail was reviewed and the meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:30 p.m.
