TOWN OF NEW BOSTON
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES

OCTOBER 11, 1994

A regular business meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Pimenta.

REQUESTED APPOINTMENTS

Lee Murray was not in due to illness.

7:00--Katie Kavachos was in to discuss a drainage concern on Clark Hill Road. She submitted a written explanation and sketch. The ditch near her driveway is very shallow due to grading. She asked that the grader not cut anymore away. The Board said they would review the site with the Road Agent. Mrs. Kavachos also expressed concerns about speeding on the road and lack of sidewalks on various roads in town.

Selectman Goodin arrived shortly after 7:30 p.m.

7:30--Wilfred Klardie, Kenneth and Lois Klardie were in to speak about their desire to upgrade and reclassify part of the Class VI portion of Pulpit Road to Class V so that they may subdivide two lots. Chairman Pimenta suggested that the Board and the Road Agent have a site walk to see the proposed area. Selectman Strong suggested that Mr. Klardie's surveyor be present also. Ms. Cleveland said in order to initiate the process, the Klardie's would need to present a petition to reclassify the road. Mr. Klardie said he would call his surveyor to have him schedule a date and time with the Board.

ADMINISTRATIVE

The Board reviewed and approved the weekly payroll and accounts payable.

The Board approved and signed a driveway permit for George Thomson, Map 10, Lot 12.

Certification of Yield Taxes were approved and signed for Francis Lordon, Map 5, Lot 40; and Richard Bouchard, Map 2, Lot 133.

The Board signed the State Election Day warrants which will be posted tomorrow.

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APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Selectman Goodin made a motion to accept the October 9 minutes as written. Chairman Pimenta seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The Board approved a three day bereavement leave request. If the employee needs more time, the Board said the request should be made in writing.

The Board reviewed two proposals for highway shed electrical work. Selectman Strong suggested that Lee meet with Dwight Lovejoy to be sure his proposal is inclusive of everything he needs. He suggested accepting Mr. Lovejoy's proposal for \$1,180 contingent on Lee's approval.

Regarding the New Boston Junior Athletic League, Selectman Goodin said the JAL would like to be under the auspices of the Town. Chairman Pimenta asked that the JAL prepare a written proposal for the Board to review and to schedule an appointment to discuss the proposal.

NEW BUSINESS

Ms. Cleveland submitted the results of recent traffic surveys on Meetinghouse Hill Road and Mill Street. Based on the results, Selectman Strong made a motion to post a 30 mph speed limit on Meetinghouse Hill Road and a 25 mph speed limit on Mill Street. Selectman Goodin seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

Selectman Strong inquired about the Town Hall Clock operation. He said that Willard Dodge is willing to continue winding the clock. Chairman Pimenta said Roland Sallada is contacting a clock repair expert in Goffstown to come speak with the Board about the operation of the clock.

Selectman Strong motioned to adjourn the meeting. Selectman Goodin seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 9:15 p. m.
