*A regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Selectman Pimenta.*

*PRESENT: Michael S. Pimenta, Selectman

*Selectman Pimenta made a motion to accept the August 26, 1996, Selectmen's public and non-public Meeting minutes. Selectman Carlstrom seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Selectman Pimenta made a motion to accept the September 9, 1996 and September 23, 1996, Selectmen's Meeting minutes. Selectman Carlstrom seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.*

*John and Mona Winslow have not kept their agreement with the Town to pay their property taxes. Selectman Pimenta made a motion to go ahead and tax deed the Winslow's property. Selectman Carlstrom seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.*

*At 9:00 p.m., Jonathan Brooks of the Forestry Committee stopped in to set a meeting place for the site walk on Saturday, October 19, 1996. The meeting place will be at the entrance to Friendly Beaver campground on Old Coach Road. Mr. Brooks left a map of the proposed trail that they are blazing on the Lydia Dodge lot. Selectman Carlstrom informed the secretary that he would not be available for the site walk.*

*Selectman Carlstrom updated the Board on the first C.I.P. meeting. C.I.P. had another offer of fill for the school expansion to make an access road. The committee also discuss cutting down the steep grade in back of the school. They felt that if they had extra material it could be stock piled at the New Boston Cemetery for the cemetery expansion.*

*Americable Group has purchased our present cable company Showcase in a bankruptcy case. The Selectmen requested that the previous contract with Showcase Cable and the limited franchise agreement with Americable Group be sent to Town Council for review. Americable Group will be meeting with the Board on October 20, 1996.*

*Selectman Pimenta informed the secretary that he would not be available this year for the Municipal Law Lecture Series.*

Selectmen Carlstrom will not be in town from November 4th through the 22nd.

The Board signed Intent-to-Cut forms. The Board reviewed and/or signed other miscellaneous correspondence and materials.

Selectmen Carlstrom made motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 p.m. Selectman Pimenta seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
