

MINUTES FOR MARCH 19, 2014

New Castle Cemetery Trustees monthly meeting at New Castle Town Hall, 3.30 p.m.

Present: Jim Cerny, Terri Golter, Carol White

1. The February minutes were approved with one correction.
- 2.1 – Current budget – The tree stump removal cost is still charged to the wrong account. Jim will ask for the charge to be debited to the tree maintenance fund not the monument repair account. The amount was \$1,000.
- 2.2 – Mike Petlick – Terri will review Mike's invoices to see exactly what has been spent. Deb Knowles stopped by and gave us copies of what has been paid Mike so Terri can compare that with the actual invoices. Terri and Deb will get together so the payments and invoices can be more accurately tracked.
- 3.1 – Cremation burial for Virginia Buonanducci in Riverside will be later this spring.
- 4.1 – We discussed the e-mail from Terry Knowles about how the interest can be spent from some of the trust funds. This needs to be sent to the TOTF and the selectmen. Jim will work on a draft letter and will send it to Terri and me for approval.
- 4.2 – Frost Cemetery status – Carol contacted Historic New England again. They think there's no problem with approval for spending the money to put up the historic sign but they may want to give some input on design and content etc. So we're still waiting on them.
- 4.3 – Marvin Cemetery right of way – Jim will check on getting a copy of the survey done for the school to see who owns the trees near this right of way. Jerry Marvin owns the right of way but the town maintains it. Some of the trees are in bad shape and will need to be removed eventually. Whose responsibility is it?
- 5.1 – NHCA meeting on April 15 – No one is available to attend this meeting.
- 5.2 – Jim is up for re-election but hasn't decided whether he'll run or not.
- 5.3 – Jim Cerny will check with Bill Stewart about the wetlands letter in regards to Oceanside Cemetery.
