

MINUTES FOR AUGUST 19, 2015

New Castle Cemetery Trustees monthly meeting at New Castle Town Hall, 3.30 p.m.

1. The July minutes were approved.

2.1 – The budget looks fine so far. We've received the July bills for mowing though the lack of rain should slow down the required mowing.

2.2 – As Kai's already done \$850 worth of cemetery repair this year, there is only \$2150 remaining in the budget. Carol has e-mailed him asking him to come talk with us about more repair work for this year. The Trustees like the before and after pictures he's been taking and he'll continue doing so.

3.1 Lot Sales –

3.3 – Pending burials/memorial services –

4.2 – Frost Cemetery and Historic New England – no progress on the historical marker. We are waiting on HNE.

4.3 – Jim and Carol will work on producing a map of all cemeteries in New Castle for Don Graves including obscure, long forgotten ones. This may not happen until this winter.

4.4 – We postponed discussing the list of Rules and Regulations for New Castle Cemeteries as Terri was not at the meeting. Jim proposes a rule that all monuments must be installed by a professional monument installer. These will be discussed and voted on during the winter.

4.5 – We are going to solicit lawn maintenance bids for next year. Terri will head this up.

4.6 – There's a dead tree in the Frost Cemetery which needs to be removed.
