





- ❑ How much more will be drained? Level will only go down further if the Town is forced to totally breach the Dam.
- ❑ What will happen to the Wildlife? Fish & Game to be contacted with respect to the decisions currently being made to the proposed rehab.
- ❑ What can we do to make this happen? Attend Town Meeting, even if individuals not registered voters. State your case, be influential. The Board reaffirmed their commitment to state the case for support given the sustained property values at Marchs Pond and Chalk Pond.
- ❑ We have no water. Nothing the town can do. Temporary repair not feasible at this time.

With respect to the proposition that the project may not be supported at Town Meeting, Selectman Bickford opined that the owners may want to consider taking over the Dam, forming a precinct and taking care of the Dam themselves as an alternative.

Chair Gehl reiterated the need for the property owners to be proactive, and that the town staff is an available resource. He also pointed out that the rehab plans were available at Town Hall for viewing.

There being no further discussion, motion Rhoades, second Bickford to close the work session at 3:30 PM, vote unanimous.
