## New Durham Board of Selectmen Public Meeting Minutes Town Hall Friday, May 8, 2015

Meeting called to order at 3:00 P.M. by Chair Bickford.

The Board discussed the Fire Department renovations. Fire Chief Varney is going to create a list of problems and concerns then have a meeting with the contractor. The Board gave the Fire Chief the authority to oversee and manage the renovation project.

There was a short discussion about the vehicle condition reports submitted by the Equipment Mechanic. The Board decided these would be discussed again at their next meeting.

Chair Bickford made a motion to go into nonpublic session, pursuant to RSA 91-A: 3 II (a) — the dismissal, promotion or compensation of any public employee or the disciplining of such employee & (c)- matter which, if discussed in public would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the public body itself, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant.

Selectman Anthes seconded the motion. Roll Call: Selectman Anthes – Aye; Chair

<u>Selectman Anthes seconded the motion.</u> <u>Roll Call: Selectman Anthes – Aye; Chair Bickford- Aye; Selectman Swenson- Aye.</u>

The Board entered nonpublic session at 3:31 P.M. in the Town Hall conference room.

<u>Selectman Swenson made a motion to seal the nonpublic minutes. Chair Bickford seconded</u> the motion. Motion passed, 3-0.

<u>Selectman Swenson made a motion to leave nonpublic session. Selectman Anthes seconded the motion. Motion passed, 3-0.</u>

The Board left nonpublic session at 6:01 P.M.

Fire Chief Varney gave the Board an update on an upcoming ambulance inspection. He stated he was worried about the security of the ambulances and drugs due to some items missing recently. He requested the cameras that were removed from the Fire Department a couple of years ago. The Board agreed the Fire Department could install the cameras. They asked for the captured images to also be delivered to the Police Department and to check with Northeast Security for a better security camera system.

The Board decided to schedule interviews for Building Inspector, Code Enforcement Officer, and Health Officer for Monday, May 11, 2015 at 6:00 and 6:45 P.M.
